Young Drivers @ Work Training Seminar

Young drivers (up to age 25 years) are one of the road user priority commitments mentioned within the Scottish Government Road Safety Framework to 2020.

Young drivers are drivers aged up to 25 years.

To support the Scottish Government commitment, RoSPA Scotland has organised two **free** training seminars in the use and delivery of RoSPA's Young Driver at Work Workshop resource.

These training seminars will take place in Edinburgh on 7th September and in Glasgow on 8th September. The seminars are open to anyone involved in working with drivers (under 25 years) and will be of particular interest to road safety professionals, police, fire, community officers, businesses, driving instructors, educationalists, businesses who employ young at-work drivers, occupational health and safety personnel. The Young Driver at Work Workshops are designed to provide an understanding of the risks young drivers face and the skills they need when driving for work.

The YD@W workshop aims to:

- Improve the attitudes and behaviour of young at-work driver
- Inform the development of organisations' road risk policies
- Facilitate the consultation of the whole organisation about work-related road safety policies and gauge how well they are followed

The YD@W Learning outcomes are

- Understand how inexperience can increase the risk of being involved in a crash
- Better understanding of how driving for work can lead to increased risk especially amongst younger drivers
- Identify the factors which can result in unsafe driving when at work
- Help the driver to understand how their employer can be a source of support
- Greater awareness of how the organisation's driving for work policies can be applied and help the driver
- Identify the wider social pressures which can lead to unsafe driving and how to overcome them
- Understand how self-reflection is important in lifelong learning to drive

The training aims to assist delegates and businesses who employ at-work young drivers in identifying new ways of helping young drivers.
